The training reinforced the many personal and professional benefits of working in a diverse and inclusive workforce and introduced the key concepts of allyship and how to advocate for diversity, equity, and inclusion.
3	Management-level training concerning methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination	On January 25, 2023, our SEU's Market Manager participated in a facilitated session and presentation conducted by the Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion ("DEI") advisory firm, H3C, entitled, <i>Cumulus Media Interactive Leadership DEI Sessions</i> . This session was a re-fresher which re-enforced and built upon the concepts of what Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion are as well as a re-cap regarding Anti-Racism and Bias & Microaggressions, which we learned about through both our initial facilitated sessions and our subsequent video trainings.

There was additional training for managers about supervisory responsibilities and how to conduct investigations regarding claims of harassment.
